The Crows Tale – Traditional tale

The children will read a traditional tale about how a crow became black before writing their own story in the same style.

Computing

This unit introduces the learners to the term 'data'. Learners will begin to understand what data means and how this can be collected in the form of a tally chart. They will learn the term 'attribute' and use this to help them organise data. They will then progress onto presenting data in the form of pictograms and finally block diagrams. Learners will use the data presented to answer questions.

Forest School

Children will take part in activities in forest school which link to other areas of learning in school. They will explore the safe use of fire as well as tools outside.

The children will also spend time in the allotment area preparing the bed for the spring and summer months linked to their learning in science.

Science

Living things and their habitats

In this unit children will investigate the different habitats in the UK and be able to identify animals and plants that can be found there. They will be able to explain if something is living, no longer living or never been alive.

They will also look at some global habitats and ways in which the animals and plants found there are suited to that habitat.

Hindu Dharma - Focus Question: How might people express their devotion? This unit enables pupils to explore some of the purpose practices associated with Hindu worship. The focus includes beliefs about Brahman, family, community and Worship.

Islam -Focus Question: Why do Muslims believe it is important to obey God? In this unit pupils will examine Islamic beliefs and practices linked to prayer. Pupils will explore the significance of prayer as one of the Five Pillars of Islam.

PE

Gymnastics – Children will be able to perform a series of rolls, balances and ways of travelling before putting together a sequence which incorporates these. The children will also look at the mechanics of movements like jumping and landing.

Net & Wall games – Be able to perform a side gallop, return a ball by striking it when thrown to them and strike a dropped ball with some consistency.

Art

LS Lowry

In this unit the children will learn about the artist Lowry, how to colour mix and recreate a collaged painting in his style.

PSHE

Is it safe to eat or drink? Is it safe to play with? Identify what items may be safe or unsafe to play with/eat or drink.

Body Language – Understanding and naming a range of emotions. Explore how feelings can be shown without words.

Water spillages – Children will look at how we can prevent accidents and the difference between being responsible and irresponsible.

History

Great Fire of London

In this unit we will look at the events leading to the Great Fire of London in terms of cause and consequence. We will look at historical evidence to draw conclusions before looking at how these event impacted on how we live today
