





Curriculum news

Reception - This week in Literacy we have been sequencing the story "Little Red Hen" and retelling the story with actions. In Maths we have been sorting objects into groups depending on their colour, shape or size. Next week we are going to start learning all about Autumn and discuss the changes in weather throughout the different seasons.

Year 1 - This week year 1 have been on to Babylon Lane to complete a traffic survey as part of our Geography work. Next week we will start our final piece of artwork - a cubist self-portrait using mixed media in blue tones!

Year 2 - Year 2 have been working extremely hard writing their reports on dragons. In Geography they have drawn a map of the classroom using a key and looked at how to stay safe in our PSHE lessons. Well done Year 2!

Year 3 – Year 3 have enjoyed having debates in English and discussing animal skeletons in science.

Year 4 - This week we have designed a demonstration of the human digestive system, considered who might help us after a cycling incident and were visited by a Muslim, who answered many of our questions about the Islamic faith.

Year 5 - This week in Year 5, we had a visitor from Chorley Mosque who came to talk to us about Islam and the Qur'an. The children wrote questions to ask and we found out a lot of information. We also listened to him reading from the Qur'an which sounded beautiful! In English, we have started analysing a formal persuasive letter, ready to start writing our own next week. We have used Microsoft Excel in science to create graphs to find patterns for human growth through childhood.

Year 6 - This week Year 6 have been beginning to look at persuasive speech in English as part of our 'Battle Cry' writing unit. They have blown me away with thier plans for blog posts about life over lockdown in Computing. In art we have continued to investigate different mediums to create self-portraits and have focussed on light and shadow.
