




## **Holiday Club**



## **Curriculum news**

**Reception -** This week we have been reading the Naughty Bus! We have been writing some super sentences for our wanted posters, to help us find the Naughty Bus! In maths we have been working on doubles and we have continued our work about People Who Help Us. 🛣 🗟 🧖

Year 1 - This week year one have been learning to sing along to 'The Yellow Submarine' and learned how to play the chorus on the glockenspiel. We are looking forward to performing our song in the next few weeks!

Year 2 - In science Year 2 have investigated how different materials and objects can be manipulated by squashing, pulling, pushing, rolling and pinching. They loved practising all the events in preparation for our Sport's Day next week. In English, they have written some outstanding stories based on the class novel: Wind in the Willows. In Re, we have looked at what you can and can't do on the Sabbath day.

Year 3 – We have enjoyed taking part in an orienteering lesson during PE with the new resources we have in school. We have also been writing stories based on the Magic Faraway Tree.

Year 4 - This week, we welcomed a new friend into our class and have loved getting to know each other, created flood warning announcements to inform the public of an imminent bursting of riverbanks, and completed the level 1 course of Bikeability.

**Year 5** - This week in history we have found out about the reasons why Athens became such a strong city. We have started to read and analyse Greek myths in English. We have also explored angles in maths and investigated the different ways of separating materials in science.
