As writers we will be: studying the novel 'Journey to the River Sea' as a theme; writing kennings and cinquains; and creating non chronological reports about the Rainforest.

We will also be concentrating on handwriting and will do a **BIG WRITE** every week.

In PSHE we will build our self-esteem and confidence. We will take part in anti-bullying week and discuss the effects of drugs.

In French we will learn the alphabet, count to 60 and learn vocabulary for colours and animals.
