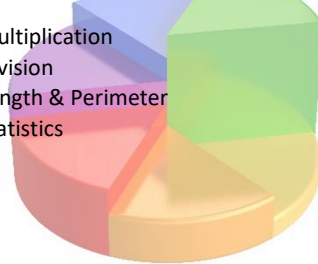

**Christianity**

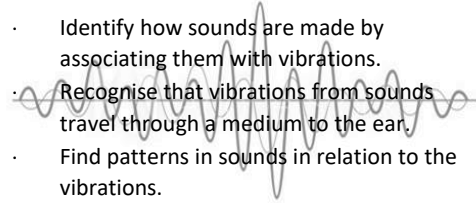
- Examine values that underpin Christian practice and belief

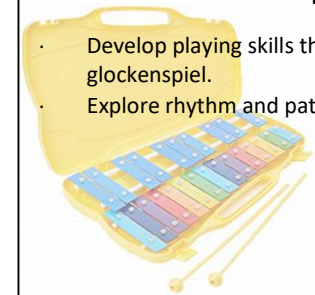

**Dance**

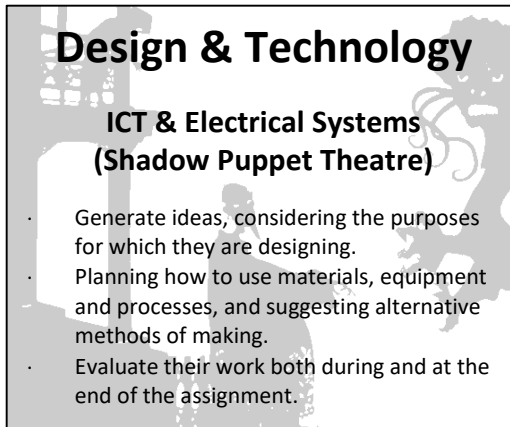
- Dance to link in with learning theme.
