## Curriculum news -What wonderful things have we been learning about this week?

**Reception** - We have been reading 'The Rainbow Fish' and learning about sharing. Next week we are learning about what may be found around the ocean.

**Year 1** – We have carried out an experiment to see what a plant needs to survive. Next week we will be looking at maps of Adlington to locate human and physical features.

**Year 2** – We have started reading our new novel – Massop's Last Chance. We have made predictions and answered questions on the text. Next week we will start our new maths unit on time.

**Year 3** – We have started our new topic in English, The Tin Forest. We are excited about writing our own stories. We have designed fruit kebabs and chosen the fruit ready to make them next week.

**Year 4** – We have innovated our inspirational text 'Snowboy and the last tree standing,' completed our unit on multiplication and division and discussed sacrifice through the Easter story.

**Year 5** – We have learnt about how coastal features are formed. We have been looking at the lessons Hindu's take from their scriptures.

**Year 6** – We have been gathering points for and against an argument for our discussions and planning a seasonal meal.
