RE

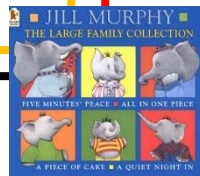
Christianity – The Church

The children will learn to talk about their own feelings and beliefs and ask questions about others. They will learn about the importance of a Baptism in Christianity and the traditions and symbols within that. They will learn about others; beliefs in God and the Church.

Science

Humans and senses

The children will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. The children will carry out a range of scientific investigations to learn about the role of each sense within our bodies.

Music

Hey You!

The children will learn the difference between pulse, rhythm and pitch. They will learn a song off by heart and play a melody within the tune using Glockenspiels. The children will perform their piece to an audience.

PE

Gym – In this unit the children will learn how to travel, roll and jump, linking their movements into a sequence.

Games – In this unit the children will learn the importance of developing their movement skills and making a ball move.

Art

Observational drawing/ painting: Self portraits

The children will use a variety of tools, including pencils, rubbers, pastels, charcoal, and chalk to create a self-portrait in the style of Picasso. They will begin to explore line, shape and colour and this will develop into paint. The children will work on different scales and use a range of paints to create different textures in their portraits.

PSHE

Keeping/ staying safe

Road safety – The children will learn about the importance of rules and how to recognise dangers and keep themselves safe. They will also learn the importance of road safety and the dangers when crossing roads.

Geography

Local Area Study: Adlington, Homes

The children will learn about and make observations of their local area using the vocabulary near, far etc. They will create a simple picture map of their classroom and use a simple key. They will carry out a simple survey of homes and traffic in the local area.
