

Curriculum news

Reception - This week we have been learning all about Autumn. We went on an autumn walk to see if we could see any signs of autumn and we wrote about what we found. In maths we have been sorting and comparing groups of conkers. Next week we will be reading Room on the Broom and learning about Halloween!

Year 1 - This week Year 1 have enjoyed taking part in our science experiment to see how strong our sense of taste was by eating crisps! Next week we will complete our cubist self-portraits. Keep an eye out for them on seesaw!

Year 2 - Year 2 have had a very busy week. We have loved mixing primary colours to make secondary colours and investigating how white and black make the colours lighter and darker. We have loved our Science experiment- How does exercise effect our body? Well done Year 2.

Year 3 - Year 3 have enjoyed learning about the artist, Hundertwasser in art. We have been learning all about his life and style of work.

Year 4 - This week, we have been coding an educational game using Scratch, begun screen printing portraits of famous faces and dissected newspaper articles as we prepare to be journalists.

Year 5 - This week in Year 5, we started swimming. The children had assessments and were put into groups. They all tried hard and listened carefully to the instructors. In art, we started our sculptures of human figures by creating the basic skeleton of our figures using the correct proportions. We also finished reading 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' and started out new class novel: 'The Girl Who Speaks Bear' by Sophie Anderson.

Year 6 - Year 6 this week have been writing their battle cry speeches and have done a fantastic job - I would happily stand with them! In science we have planned investigations into the effect of exercise on our heart focussing on static exercises such as the plank. In History the children have been researching who the Vikings were and about Viking warriors.
