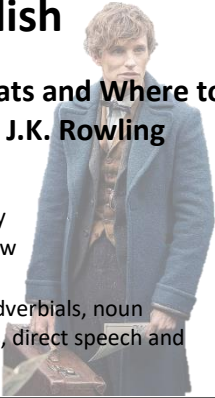

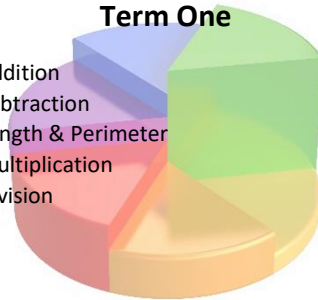

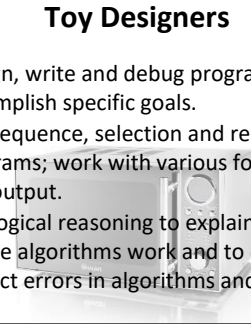

Christianity (Light)

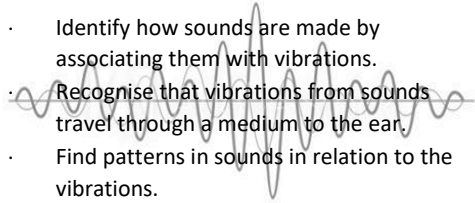
- Examine values that underpin Christian practice and belief

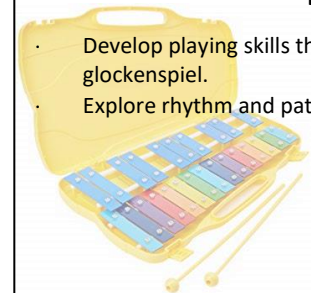

Dance

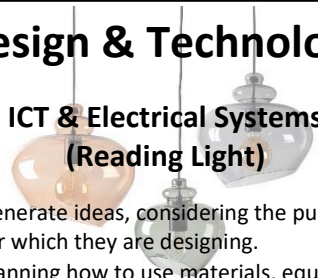
- Dance to link in with learning theme.

ICT & Electrical Systems (Reading Light)

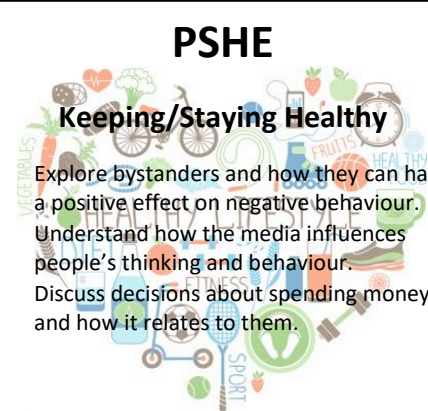
- Generate ideas, considering the purposes for which they are designing.
