COVID case reporting



If a child tests positive who has been in school this would result in their bubble 'bursting' and all children and staff within that bubble being asked to self-isolate. The bubble would be closed due to staff isolation and therefore even a child who hadn't been in contact would still have to remain at home.

Reception - This week we have been learning about Arctic Animals. We read the story Lost and Found and have read-told the story and written sentences about how the characters may have been feeling.
